

Mix/materials – meeting specific needs of each layer Thickness design – preventing non-surface cracking Preservation – safe, durable, renewable surface.

## Innovation Deployment

Facilitate the right kind of change in practice

Focus on mix produced in plant placed on roadway

Mistake to start with mechanistically elegant solution

From QC laboratory to mix design to DOT approval

Concise specification that agency can enforce

Certainty of bidding and building a profitable project.



## **Technical Support**

Mix/materials, thickness design, preservation

Design alternatives on the front end of projects

Forensics if negative outcomes are encountered

Specification recommendations (construction focus)

Experiences with innovation, products, technologies

Cautionary tales to avoid making similar mistakes.

## **Ensuring Mix Quality**

Legacy volumetrics developed for virgin, neat Modern mixes w/ RAP, RAS, polymer, additives, etc. Confounding effect of true versus assumed Gsb Gsb can be estimated via a Gse mix design offset Legacy volumetric tools for mix optimization, but... Need for spec compliance rapid BMD index testing Monotonic mix brittleness tests tend to correlate In other words, low IDEAL-CT  $\propto$  low IFIT.  $\triangle$
