- > 9.5mm NMAS surface mix
- ➤ Minimum PG64-22 grade
- > Use any materials, RAP encouraged
- > Judging breakdown:
 - APA torture test (25%) thank you IDOT!
 - Written report (35%)
 - Cost analysis (10%)
 - Video presentation (30%)
- > Five judges, \$1000 first place prize
